

ORDINANCE NO. 14

ORDINANCE OF THE UKIAH VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3, PROVIDING FOR REVISED  
COMPUTATION OF SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES

The Board of Directors of the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District ordains as follows:

1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. The connection charge provided for by this Ordinance shall be a minimum of \$100 per parcel and shall be computed by the District Engineer as follows:

CONNECTION FEE PER ACRE

<u>Residential and Agricultural Zoning</u>	<u>Commercial and Public Facility Zoning</u>	<u>Industrial Zoning</u>
\$ 100	\$ 350	\$ 1,300

Fee shall be paid at time of connection and shall be computed based upon parcel size and zoning at time of connection.

2. All other sections of said Ordinance No. 3 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Ordinance shall become effective January 18, 1990.
