

ORDINANCE OF THE UKIAH VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT  
TO USE PORTION OF SEWER USER CHARGES FOR REPAYMENT  
OF STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN TO CONSTRUCT STATE  
MANDATED UPGRADING OF SEWER TREATMENT FACILITY

The Board of Directors of the Ukiah Valley Sanitation  
District ordains as follows:

"Section 1. The Ukiah Valley Sanitation District shall pay to the City of Ukiah a portion of the Sewer User Charges defined in sections 8.2 and 8.4 of Ordinance No. 12 towards repayment of the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District's proportionate share of the State of California Revolving Fund Loan used to finance the State of California mandated upgrading of the waste treatment plant and related facilities, Project No. C-06-4102-110. The portion of the Sewer User Charges to be so used shall be determined by the District's Board of Directors. These incremental payments from the Sewer User Charges shall remain in effect until such state loan is fully paid unless modification of such payments is approved in writing by the State of California Water Resources Control Board.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption and will be published as required by law in the Ukiah Daily Journal, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the County of Mendocino."
