

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE UKIAH VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 22

The Board of Directors of the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District finds as follows:

As a result of the City of Ukiah's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) being near or at treatment capacity, the Board of the Ukiah Valley Sanitation District (Board) adopted Ordinance No. 22 on November 7th, 2002 placing limitations on new sewer connections within the District.

The placing of limitations on new sewer connections was intended to allow the City of Ukiah sufficient time to negotiate an Engineering Services Contract for the design of the needed WWTP expansion improvements and for the preparation of a treatment capacity study of the WWTP (Optimization Study). The purpose of the Optimization Study was to identify short-term treatment modifications that, if implemented, could increase capacity during the interim period until the permanent plant improvements are completed.

The City of Ukiah entered into an Engineering Services Contract with Brown and Caldwell for the design of the needed plant expansion and for the preparation of the Optimization Study.

As a result of the Optimization Study, Brown and Caldwell has reported that an additional 920 equivalent sewer services (ESSU) could be safely added to the District and City's sewer collection systems with the implementation of the Chemical Enhancement to the Primary Treatment (CEPT) process. The Optimization Report was presented to the Board on December 17, 2003.

The District staff issue permits for connections to the District's sewer collection system and staff maintains a list of connections and corresponding ESSUs thereby maintaining strict control of the number of connections being added to the sewer collection system.

Based on the above findings, the Board ordains as follows:


"Ordinance No. 22 is repealed in its entirety."

This Ordinance shall become effective June 4, 2004.
